We are encouraging our patients to register for **NHS App** where you can **order your medications** directly in our clinical system from a doctor without need to contact us and you can see progress of your medication from comfort of your home.

Alternatively you can speak to **your pharmacist** if they can order medications on your behalf or bring us the **green slip** and order these directly from us.
